Provides therapeutic comfort, physical activity or social engagement to many people.				
Provides emotional support and companionship to owner.				
Trained to assist with specific tasks and support individuals with disabilities.				
Required to behave and support individuals in various settings .				
Has a legal right to access public spaces like restaurants and stores.				
Has housing rights even if there is a “No Pets” policy.				
Has travel rights in the cabin of an airplane with owner.				
Fine to approach and ask to pet in public.				
Assigned to and supports one institution or facility on a regular basis.				
Allowed in specific non-pet friendly public locations with prior approval.
